

Directions to Central Link and Central St. James

Central Link and Central St. James are situated on Wellington Street close to St James' Park football stadium and the city centre.

Full Address: Central Link or Central St. James, Wellington Street, Newcastle, NE4 5SA

Directions by road:

From the North and West take the A167 exit from A1, following the signs for City Centre for approximately 3km. At the Cowgate roundabout take the first exit onto the A167 (City Centre). At Cow Hill junction branch left, then turn right at traffic signal onto the A189 (City West & The South). At Stanhope Street junction turn right onto Stanhope Street (Arthur's Hill). Turn left onto Diana Street, left onto Pitt Street and right onto Wellington Street. Central Link is located on the left hand side of the road.

From the North and West (to avoid Great North Run traffic) take the A69/A186 exit from the A1 and take the exit from the roundabout onto the A186 (City Centre), heading onto West Road. Continue straight along West Road as it runs into Westgate Road. After approx 4km from the A1, turn left into Corporation Street, and then left into Wellington Street. Central Link is located on the right hand side of the road.

From the South take the A1 heading past the Angel of the North indicating beginning of Gateshead area. Turn off the A1 onto the A184 (Gateshead, Newcastle Centre). Cross the Redheugh Bridge A189 signposted City Centre north and Ashington onto Blenheim Street. Follow the road passing the Grosvenor Casino on the left. At the third set of traffic lights turn left (before National Tyres) into Wellington Street. Central Link is located on the right hand side of the road.

On-site Parking: Parking in the area during intake weekend will be very limited and once you have unloaded your belongings you will be asked to move your vehicle from Wellington Street. Alternative parking can be found in the immediate vicinity and surrounding areas. You will find details of city centre car parks on Newcastle City Council [website](#).

By public transport: St James Metro station is a short walk away. There are Metro trains every 10 minutes to and from this station, with direct trains to Newcastle International Airport and Newcastle Central Station. Central Link is within five minutes' walk of the city centre where there are buses, Metros and trains to all locations.

For bus times and fares refer to Nexus Travel Line at www.nexus.org.uk or contact them by telephone on 0871 200 2233. Calls to this number will cost 10 pence a minute from a landline and considerably more from a mobile.

By train: From Newcastle Central Station you can take the Metro to St James Station. Taxis are also available from the Central Station.

By air: Newcastle International Airport is about seven miles northwest of Newcastle University. A taxi from the Airport will take about 15 minutes, costing approximately £15. You can also travel by Metro (rapid transport system) to St James Station which will take approximately 20–25 minutes.

A detailed map can be posted or faxed if required by contacting Reception. Please note, the University has provided this information as the most advisable route to Central Link and Central St. James. Your Satellite Navigation ('Sat Nav') system may offer alternative instructions but we advise you to follow the above.
